WEEKEND BREAKFAST • BAGGED LUNCH • DINNER

There are many ways to feed a family, but preparing a meal shows a personal warmth and care for families who are facing difficult moments.

DINNER ANY DAY 2:30 PM - 5:00 PM

Groups are responsible for planning a menu, providing all necessary ingredients and supplies and using the House kitchen and equipment to cook. All prep work and cooking must be done at RMHCPT and cannot be done at home. Groups typically cook for 45, and you will receive an exact count on the Monday of your cooking week. After cooking, your group will portion out meals in individual to-go containers and label them with the contents and date. Labels are provided by the House and groups are asked to bring the to-go containers.

LUNCH MONDAY - FRIDAY 9:30 AM - 11:30 AM



Provide items for a basic bag lunch: a sandwich, bag of chips, fruit, dessert, and water or juice. Volunteers provide the ingredients, paper bags, plastic sandwich bags, and condiments. Groups prepare 50 lunches.

BREAKFAST

WEEKENDS ONLY 8:30 AM - 10:30 AM

BAKING WITH LOVE

ANY DAY

9:30 AM - 11:30 AM OR 12:00 PM - 2:00 PM

Volunteers select their own recipes and provide ingredients for cookies, brownies, muffins, or cakes. Please bring plastic sandwich bags to portion items.
